
11 Different Pathways, around 14 projects per each.

Level 2	<ul> <li>Learning Your Style</li> <li>Understanding Your Style (path-specific speech)</li> <li>Skill Development</li> <li>Introduction to Toastmasters Mentoring</li> </ul>
Level 3	<ul> <li>Two Elective projects (2x speeches)</li> <li>Path-specific speech</li> </ul>
Level 4	<ul> <li>One Elective projects</li> <li>Path-specific speech</li> </ul>
Level 5	<ul> <li>Reflect on Your Path</li> <li>Path-specific speech</li> <li>One Elective project</li> </ul>
